

IN FIXING PROFITS Size, Diversity and Productive-

The factors most important in de-termining the profits in farming are size, diversity, and productivity of the business, according to W. E. Grimes, assistant professor of farm manag-ment in the Kansas State Agricultural college. ment in the Kansas State Agricultural college. "Of these factors, the one which confronts farmers is diversity of busi-ness," said Mr. Grimes. "Too many farmers derive the greater part of helr income from one enterprise, which if it falls leaves them without resources.
