Establishment of the Michigan Patriotic Fund is in accord with the request of President Wilson, as voiced
in a letter to Raymond D. Fosdick. Commissioner on Training Camp Activities. In this letter the president pointed out that the services rendered by the different agencies to our army

by the different agencies to our army and to our allies are essentially one and must of necessity be rendered in the closest co-operation. He asked that appeals for funds be united in grader that the spirit of the country may be expressed without distinction of race or religious opinion. Seven large national organizations engaged in war work will be represented in this drive. They are the Y. M. C. A. War Fund, the War Camp Community Service, the Y. W. C. A. War Fund, the Fairvalion Army and the American Library Association.
