Roy Montgomery Writes to His Mother, and Tells of Meeting Old Friends.

Signal Base, Witley, Aug. 15 '18

Dear Mother:

Yesterday we all had a pass just for the day in London as it was Canadian Sports or Athletic Day. I had the best time for one day that I ever had.

We went to a good cafe and I had a good eat like I used to get. A lobster at noon and a half chicken at evening, also strawberry ice, good coffee and a French Pastry.

I met Corporal Reed a Yankee from Bill H's Squad and he is stationed now in London he took us to the Y. M. C. A. and we had a dandy plunge and shower and tea and pool afterwards.

As I was waiting for train time at the Waterloo station, I looked around and you never could guess who I met right there in London. It was Stuart Allen from Birmingham and he is at a camp not far from London and we can get together again soon as my train was due I only had a few minutes with him.

He has only been here a very short time and you better telephone his mother and tell her he is in London and really he is happy and looking splendid.

Well mother we got our train and about half way home the train slowed up and stopped in some R. R. yards. "Here" and "There" we were looking out the window and we were stopped right beside a train load of Yankee soldiers and we were looking at them and you could have heard them yell in Michigan, they had just landed that day and they were where they were from the one I was talking to said "Great Lakes Training Station", well that was a knock-out blow, my heart just stopped for I thought "Oh if Jim is only with them" but I inquired further and they said he was more likely on some of the big Atlantic patrols.

The trains were so close together we could shake hands from the windows and all one could see was hands going up and down all along the line and the "Yanks" yelling "Hurrah for Canada" and the Canadians yelling "Good Ol Yanks" the Yanks ask me what part of Canada I was from and I answered Detroit, Mich., well they had a fellow from Detroit but he was unlucky and got shot in "God Window" but his pals all moved back and made room in fact nearly pushed him over to me, I did not notice catch his name but I remember he lived out West Port Street.

I must speak of the remarks I heard after the trains parted, and hope every one at home will hear of them, the Canadian casualty list, particularly on my train kept saying "What a fine clean cut crowd they are" and "Yes every one of them is a man" and "My but don't they look big and healthy", while I sat back in my corner with a smile on my face and a pain in my heart for I did want to go with my own boys mother and some times it does hurt just a little but the Canadian Boys are using me just like one of their own brothers so it is really alright you know.

But I can't help but say again that, that crowd of "Yank" Sailors is the best looking body of men I have yet seen and not putting any flowers on myself I will say I have seen a few. My candle will soon be gone so I can't write any more letters tonight but I must write Hilda Howard just a few lines and some of the boys. East-tomorrow or very soon, you might show this to Frank and he can consider it a stand off for a few days. As Ever ROY.

As a result of the contest between canning demonstration teams, in which 29 clubs were represented the score of 91 per cent or 8th place. The canning team from Coldwater came last with a score of 66 per cent.

A demonstration team consists of 3 members, ranging in age from 16-18, but of equal enthusiasm for the possibilities of cold pack canning.

These girls with their leader, Mrs. E. A. Shal, have met at the canning on Center Wednesday of each week, to help in the conservation of surplus garden products, from that community. A real bit of patriotic service. In this way, under direction by the Supervisor, they have received the training and experience which qualifies them as authorities on the canning of all vegetables and fruits the "Cold Pack Wax."

The demonstrators were: Doris Lillycrop, 12 years, of Keego Harbor.

Blanch Gotzka, 15 years, and Mildred Stevens, 12 years, who had the demonstration included the canning of 2 vegetables and a fruit with explanation of other products not represented and discussion of steps in the process of canning.

Their enthusiasm and success represents an achievement worthy of congratulation and a stepping stone to future success in club work and community service.

DIED SUDDENLY

Charles Stinchfield, of Bloomfield Hills, Stricken While on His Way to Winter Home.

Charles Stinchfield, 70 years old, pioneer Michigan lumberman and director in several of Detroit's most extensive industrial enterprises, died suddenly Tuesday at Lake Tahoe, California, while en route to his winter home at Pasadena, Cal.

Mr. Stinchfield, member of one of New England's most sturdy families, was born at Lincoln, Me. With his father he came to Michigan when 16 years old, and at the age of 20, where his father died, assuming control of the latter's lumber interests.

He formed a partnership with David Whitney, Jr., and was associated with him for many years. He held business relations with other Detroit enterprises.

He maintained residences at Detroit, Bloomfield Hills, Pontiac and Pasadena. He left Detroit for the west last November.

Mr. Stinchfield was a member of Detroit club, Bloomfield Golf club and the old Lake St. Clair Hunt club. He is survived by his widow and three children: Charles Stinchfield, Jr., is the son. The daughters are Mrs. L. A. Hopkins, of Minnetka, Ill., and Mrs. William Van Dyke, of Groveland, Minn. His mother died in Detroit little more than a year ago, when 94 years old.

Mrs. Stinchfield is en route east with the body and no funeral arrangements will be announced until after her arrival.
