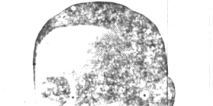

VOTE ON APRIL 7 MERELY AUTHORIZES PEOPLE TO USE CREDIT OF STATE.

Not a Bond Issue

Section 3 of Article X of the Constitution makes no provision for bonding this State, borrowing money, or issuing bonds of any kind. We want to expand this section to cover road bonds and make Federal Aid in road bonds available to Michigan.
