### MOTORISTS FACE PROBLEM OF GAS

Automobile and Petroleum Men Must Get Together in Close Harmonious Co-operation.

### INCREASE IN MOTOR CARS

Said to Be Possible to Construct Internal Combustion Engines Which Will Consume Much Less Fuel of Inferior Kind.

"The petroleum fuel problem will have to be solved in the automobile industry and the petroleum industry get together in close and harmonious cooperation," says Mark L. Ropp, general director of the oil division of the United States road administration, in an interview, which appears in Motor, the national magazine of motoring.

"The motor fuel problem is not only a possibility of the future," continues Mr. Ropp, "but it is a reality of the present, as will be understood by anyone who takes the trouble to make even the most cursory examination of the situation. In 1912 our production of petroleum was 222,000,000 barrels of 42 gallons. In 1914 the output of this basic product of motor fuel was 200,000,000 barrels, an increase in four years of less than 20 per cent. On the other hand, in 1912 there were about 1,000,000 motor vehicles in the country, while in 1914 the motor population of the United States had risen to 2,241,728. This represents an increase of over 200 per cent in four years. With one side of the equation growing less than 20 per cent and the other side increasing more than 200 per cent, the fuel situation is not hard to foresee."

### Engine Uses Less Oil

"I am not an automobile engineer," says Mr. Ropp, "but I have been interested in it possible to design internal combustion engines which will consume much less fuel per mile than is now being consumed, and of a much inferior quality. If this is a fact and the automobile industry faces the situation in cooperation with the oil men to effect this saving, while these latter are devising their best effort to increase production, it would seem that we might cut enough of each end of our problem to solve it."

"It seems to be only at the beginning of the gasoline era, a few years ago, gasoline was a wasted by-product; today it is the most important product of petroleum, amounting to almost 50 per cent of the total value of petroleum products. With the record of the past as a guide, it would seem that the two great industries so interdependent on each other should be co-operating in solving the most vexing problem of the present."

### HANDLE BATTERY WITH CARE

Motorist Should Economize on Current and Keep Engine Tuned to Start on Second Turn.

The man who has trouble keeping his battery charged will find that it hardly rarely can be overcome by constant recharging. In other words, he should economize on current. He should keep his engine tuned up so that it starts on the second or third turn. Thus he can minimize the amount of current used in starting and, consequently, this is very important. The current required is 200 to 300 amperes as much as required by an ordinary domestic power house light.

He should also be economical with his lights. He should not use head lights only when absolutely necessary. He should determine the car speed at which his current meter indicates maximum with the motor, and separate the car as much as possible above this speed.

If he drives much in a congested city street and stops his engine many times he will find that his battery will be kept more nearly charged by changing the gears in traffic whenever possible, instead of trying to do it all at high gear, the reason being that by changing gears he loses less engine speed so that his battery is charged while if he tried to pull slowly on high he gets down to a speed at which the charging stops due to the opening of the circuit.

### NEW HEADLIGHT FOR MOTORS

Nevada Inventor Provides Mechanism for Operating Lights Around Curves in Road.

The Scientific American, in illustrating and describing a desirable headlight operating mechanism, the invention of E. V. Smith of Fallon, Nev., says:

"This inventor provides a mechanism for operating the headlights of motor vehicles whereby they may follow the curves and turns in the road in illuminating the same, incorporating means whereby the headlights operating mechanism may be thrown into and out of operation at will. He provides a mechanism coupled with the steering gear and movable into and out of operation therewith, in order that, if desired, the light may be kept stationary while the vehicle is traveling."

### DELICATE CAR DOOR POCKETS

Wooden Strips May Be Securely Fastened by Using Flat, Round-headed Screws.

Many cars are afflicted with inadequate door pockets, those which are made of inferior material or are too poorly fastened. These are apt to tear loose at the corners, especially where they are merely held on wooden strips attached to the door. When this happens they may be securely fastened by using round-headed screws, which should have flat heads when the material is black. These same screws can be used in attaching to the interior lining of the door, especially at the corners.

### FIND LUBRICATING FAILURE

Car Owner Should Emulate Example of Locomotive Engineer by Using Hand to Find Trouble.

The locomotive engineer frequently uses his hand to determine lubricating failure and this is a hint that the car owner can put to good use. Failure of lubrication permits excessive wear and friction, generating heat. As part which is discovered to be too hot to the hand held near it is probably suffering from faulty lubrication.
