

HEARSES HOLD UP TRAFFIC IN VIENNA AND OTHER PARTS OF HORROR-STRICKEN EUROPE. SAYS BRITISH RELIEF WORKER

In Serbia Alone, Declares Sir William Goode, There Are 750,000 Fatherless Children; Sees Bolshevism As Menace to Whole World

Europe the cities of Vienna, Prague and Budapest are the worst. The statement made by Sir William Goode, British director of relief work, before the American Luncheon Club in London.

"I feel upon leaving Vienna," he said, "as though I had spent 10 days in the cell of a condemned murderer who has given up all hope of a reprieve. I stayed at the hotel, but I could not sleep and ate the whole time. I was there in the bitter cold of the winter, once the car-bomb had been thrown. The Austrian had been together in the gloom of one light."

"They were more like shadows than representatives of the rich. Vienna's world famous Opera House is packed every afternoon. Why? Women and men go there in order to keep warm and because they have no work to do."

Traps An Experiment
"In my office I have several experiments at work in an experiment with a net for the fall when the thermometer inside was only one degree below freezing point. Finally, I determined to get wood enough to light the one small fire for two days. It cost me 900 kroner, which is the equivalent of about \$150."

"The women that I see to do the people in Vienna are burning the furniture to get their clothes. Can you imagine how the poor live or try to live? It is not unusual to see the traffic in one of the main streets which leads to the cemetery, and up the hills. Nymphets carry the bodies of children."

In Serbia alone, Sir William declared, there are 750,000 fatherless children, most of whom are suffering from hunger and exposure.

"It seems to me that you cannot talk with variation and precision about Central Europe such as you do today in Vienna without running the risk of a car-bomb. I believe, which probably probably not be confined to the continent."
