To the Editor: In a recent editorial you ask what sort of a town is yours in good case of a hard week. The editorial that asked this question had for its theme the idea that a man's opinion of the town in which he lives depends entirely on his viewpoint. I am writing you on this subject.

In looking to view this town as it all with the attitude of critic or cynic but rather as one who has lived here the past years, and who hopes to make Birmingham his permanent home, and who therefore tries to express himself entirely from the viewpoint of civic interest.

No one who lives here can help but take pride in the natural beauty of Birmingham with its great old trees and its green lawns. And in the city limits there are those who are Birmingham's pride. Birmingham seems like an ideal garden spot in which all children can flower into youth. In all it seems an ideal village to live in and raise a family.

But of what use is the beauty of the place, its schools, and its fresh air if we can't have sufficient water supply to enjoy them? Suppose a man was contemplating Birmingham as a place of residence. He would be interested about our water supply, a very vital question. If we answered him truthfully, we'd have to tell him that our water supply in the world, but on a summer day you never know whether or not you're going to get water to allow you to use your bath room.

Right then, the main interest in Birmingham as a place to make his home, would cease. During the past four years the water supply has been very low, particularly during the summer months, and of course, has been insufficient for use. And, obviously every month was aware of the shortage. That does not mean that the people just make do and endure it, while the authorities who are responsible for our water supply, make the water run out with no water to put out the fire.

Thus, the village officials had better be sure that the water supply has been restricted by the courts from using it. We can't blame the village for that restriction. And Mr. Joseph Mack has offered a cooperative plan to supply water. But in the meantime the city suffers from both, both tub remains unsold.

We know there are difficulties connected with this task. It's the difficulties that constitute any task, but all of us are paid to produce results in face of the obstacles that they confront us. I guess that's about all there is to living, anyway—climbing over, around and through them. One civic high road is very good, about leaving a village a year old bog from making in the sidewalk with its water works. They're generally willing to take in the street, the city, and the roads who drive their boys at 30 miles per hour. If they're not making in administering the affairs of the village, and in stopping those speed demons as they are, they're not doing their duty. The law against the heavy chain of the law against the heavy chain, will have all the water as well, even enough for the public drinking fountains.

When confronted with a crisis in the water situation here, the village officials will be in a very tight spot. This puts no restriction on most of us for the very good and simple reason we haven't even been able to get enough water to drink. They might just as well announce that drinking water is forbidden after July 4th. From here that had not, it can not be taken away.

It is quite possible that the village directors are doing many things to relieve the situation, but they're doing nothing about it. If they are out of fairness to themselves and us, they should make the facts known. If they're doing anything at all, they should have some development to announce at least once a week. As matters now stand the situation is one that demands the immediate and energetic action of the village officials. Our village officials are not elected for the political honor, they are elected because they believe they are to manage and produce. Let's put a little bit of real man into management and take care of the water, anything to get some water.

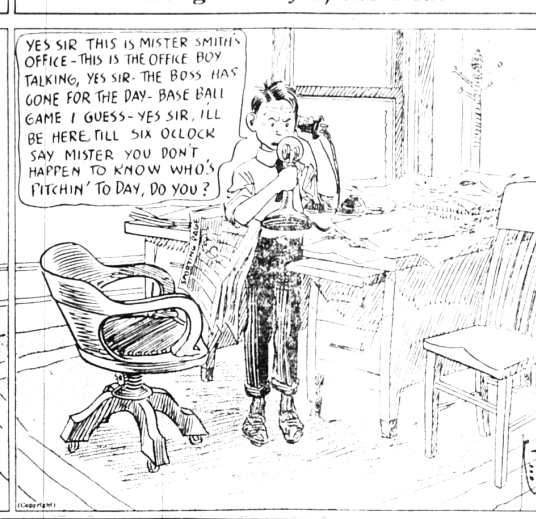
