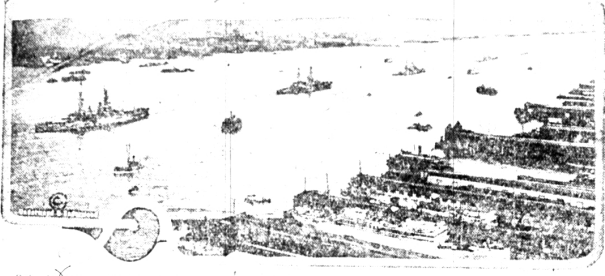


# Atlantic Fleet Back From West Indies

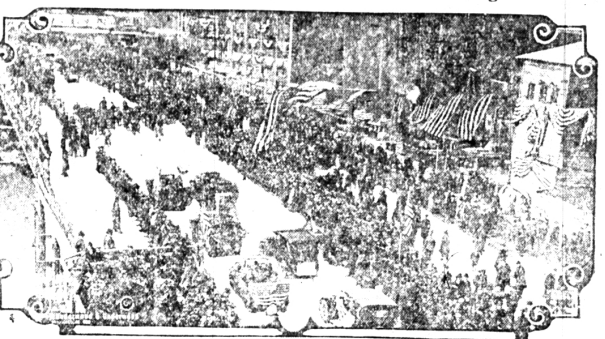

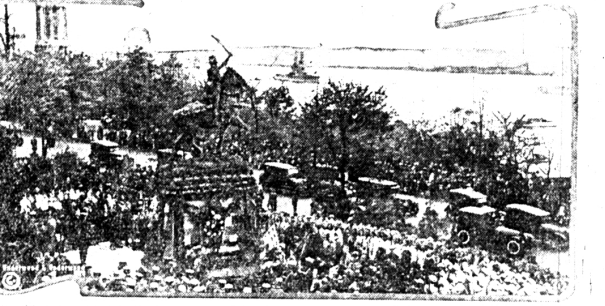

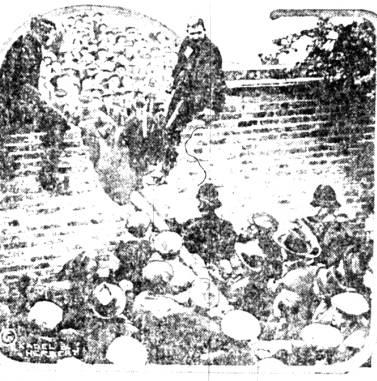

### Professor Snyder of Philadelphia Explains Recent Great Auroral Display.

# PROFESSOR SNYDER'S EXPLANATION

### Due to Hydrogen Particles

### Phenomena Is But Legible Result of Explosive Ejection of the Electric Hydrogen From the Sun.

Philadelphia, Sept. 12.—The earth was struck by a powerful aurora on the night of Sept. 11, which was described as the most brilliant auroral display in recent years. Professor Snyder of the University of Pennsylvania explains the phenomenon as being due to the explosive ejection of electric hydrogen from the sun.

# Passing Through Solar Corona

The professor explains that the aurora is the result of the sun's corona passing through the earth's atmosphere. The corona is a layer of gas that surrounds the sun and is composed of hydrogen and helium.
