

## WILL DECIDE ON JAIL BOND ISSUE

### OAKLAND COUNTY WILL VOTE APRIL 5 ON PROPOSED SURETY PLAN

Oakland county voters will decide at the spring election whether they will support a bond issue for the purpose of building a new jail. The present building is too small for the needs of the growing community, and it is estimated that the cost of a new building would be about \$1,000,000. The issue will be voted on April 5.

The county has under consideration a site for a new jail building. The site is located on the corner of 11th and 12th streets. The building would be about 100 feet long and 50 feet wide. It would have a capacity of about 100 prisoners.
