COUNTRY'S FIRST CORY MILL

Recent Discoveries Establish Its Site at a Point on the St. Croix River, Eastport, Me.

The site of what undoubtedly was the first transactor mill on the American continent has been discovered at Eastport, Me., where Lewis Brook empties into the St. Croix river at a point nearly opposite the southern end of Deer's Island, where De Mearns and his men settled in the year 1604, three years before the settlement of Jamestown. In excavating for a high point near his summer home, R. S. McCord of Cambridge, Me., unearthed the unmistakable remains of an ancient mill of stone and timber. Comparing the site with the original map of the island, authorities agreed that it must have been the site of the mill mill mentioned in the old records as employed by Sir de Monts and his men to grind their corn, being the largest stream within an area of several miles on either side of the river.
