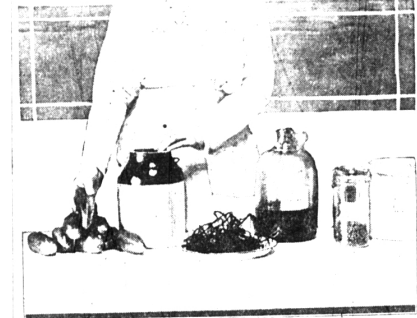

Dill Pickles Are an Old-Fashioned Favorite.

Pickles possess little food value but they add zest and variety to a meal. They are the jazz element in the ordinary, worth and are well worth the time and money the housewife expends in the making of them. Now is the time to lay in a supply for the winter, and below are given some simple recipes recommended by home-land specialists of the United States department of agriculture.

**Tomato Relish**  
Squid and shell fish are small pieces, six or eight pieces. Peel the tomatoes, seed them. Chop all of these very fine using a food chopper or mince machine. Put into a large bowl and add a level teaspoonful of salt, a level teaspoonful of vinegar and a level teaspoonful of oil. Bring to a boil and boil slowly. The reason for a slow boil is to save the color and to cook the tomatoes and shell fish hot. This is a good relish and is very easy to make. It is a good relish for use on bread, butter, and eggs.

**Another Use for Tomatoes**  
Take ripe tomatoes. Cut in half, cook thoroughly, strain through a colander or sieve. To one gallon of the strained pulp add two fat spoonsful of salt, one of pepper, three of sugar, one of powdered mustard, two parts of red pepper, sliced and with seeds removed, and a small muslin bag containing one to two pounds of whole allspice, one of whole cinnamon bark, one of peppercorns and one of whole cloves. Boil rapidly for one to two hours or until thick; then add two cupsful of vinegar, boil again if necessary to thicken further after taking out the spice bags. Pour into washed bottles and seal while hot with hot wax or clogged while only may be added to the tomato pulp.

USE BEANS AND PEAS FOR NEEDED PROTEIN

Less Milk, Meat and Eggs Are Required.

Combinations of Foods Which Supply as Much of Essential Substance as One Fourth Pound of Beef of Average Composition.

Beans and peas contain more protein than other fresh vegetables. The protein, however, is not the same as the proteins of meat, milk or egg. Food specialists of the United States department of agriculture say that beans and peas are good sources of protein and should not be used to the exclusion of the others. When, however, beans and peas are fresh, low milk, meat and eggs are needed. The following lists combinations of foods which supply as much protein as one fourth pound of average beef.

Eight or nine ounces of shelled green peas or beans. A large dish of green peas or beans. A large dish of green peas or beans.

One cupful of shelled green peas or beans. A large bean casserole, made with skimmilk instead of cream, or a cupful of shelled green peas or beans.

POPCORN QUITE DELICIOUS

Besides Being Source of Entertainment for Children, It Has Important Food Value.

Besides being a source of entertainment for the children, popcorn, unlike the corn kernel cooked whole, instead of being ground and then cooked, obviously has a high food value, as well as a good one when properly prepared for the table. It may acceptably take the place of many of the breakfast foods now on the market. Popcorn may be eaten plain, or sugar like other breakfast cereals, or the parched kernels which dry out "popcorn" can be ground like coffee and eaten with cream and sugar, or can be boiled with water and served the ordinary.

Use Chamals on Brass Beds. Never wash a brass bed; wipe away all dust and remove any finger marks by lightly rubbing with a piece of chamals very slightly dampened.

MAKE HOME MORE EFFICIENT

One of Popular Projects in Counties in Which Home Demonstration Agents Assist.

Increased home efficiency is one of the popular projects in 27 counties in which home demonstration agents are maintained by the United States department of agriculture and the agricultural colleges. Last year 195 counties in the North and West carried on projects of this kind for the purpose of home efficiency, and 1,057 farm families in the same territory were assisted during that time in rearranging furniture or kitchen as an important first step in efficient housekeeping.

In the 15 Southern states last year 1,163 hog houses were built according to plans advised by the home demonstration agents. 2,236 round and 2,511 labor-saving devices made or purchased.

CARE IN WASHING ALUMINUM

Metal Does Not Tarnish Easily in Ordinary Use, but Caution Must Be Used in Cleaning.

Aluminum does not tarnish easily in ordinary use but one caution should be observed in cleaning. All acids dissolve aluminum, therefore should not be washed with strong soap, nor should scouring powders containing free alkali be used on it. Frequent use of aluminum may be rubbed off with whitening or fine steel wool (grade 00), or dissolved by the acid in vinegar, or as dilute sulfuric acid. These acids must be thoroughly washed off the aluminum. Some special preparations for cleaning aluminum are on the market.

All Around the House

Use a peltor to fill small jelly glasses.

Embroider an arrow-head design over the runner in your silk stockings.

A plain, slightly salted, crisp cracker goes better with cream than anything else.

Put pointers on the inside of aprons near the outer edge and they will not catch on door knobs and get torn.

Any article that is to be dried, such as croquettes, chops or fish, is much better tasting and more moist if dipped in bread instead of cracker crumbs.

A watermelon or cantaloupe can be quickly cooled for immediate use by being wrapped in wet cloths and set directly in the wind of an electric fan.
