ASSASSINATION OF GARFIELD

1831—Nov. 19, James Abram Garfield, born at Orange, Ohio.

1861—March 4, James A. Garfield, inaugurated 20th president, aged fifty.

Mar. 23, sent to senate the nomination of federal officers in New York City.

July 2, Garfield shot by Charles J. Guiteau at Washington.

Sept. 19, removed to Elberon, N. J., Sept. 19, died, aged fifty.

1862—June 7, nominated for President by Republican Convention at Chicago.

November, elected President.

JAMES ABRAHAM GARFIELD was the last of the presidents born and bred in log cabins.

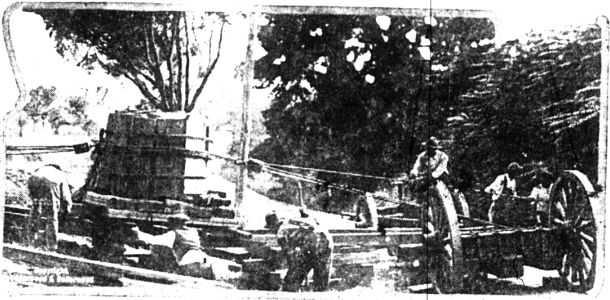

Salvation Army Dedicates New Training School



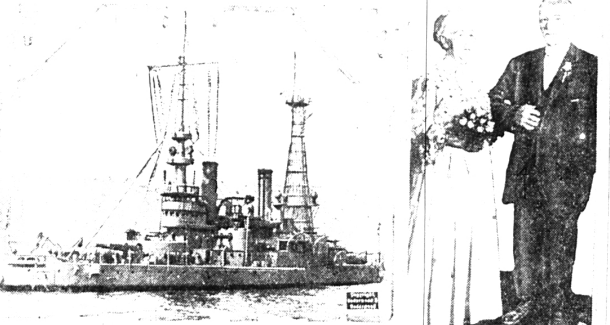
Commissioner Thomas Estill of the Salvation Army dedicated the new Columbus training school for Salvation Army officers.

Ancient Trees for the Lincoln Memorial



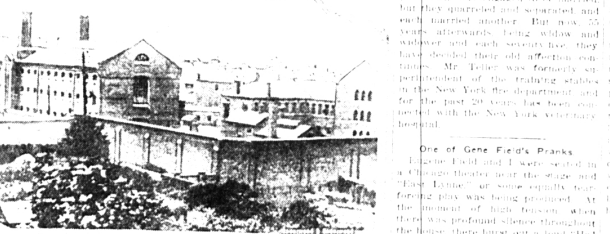
The moving of a number of boxwood trees, ranging in age from 100 to 200 years, to be transplanted around the Lincoln Memorial in Washington.

The unprecedented stimulus given highway construction in the United States in the four years since the Federal Highway Act was passed.

The participation of the national government in highway improvement marked a departure from a policy which had been followed for nearly a century.

Second only in importance to the size of the present road building program is the extension of the character of the roads being built.

In 1917, the total expenditures for roads and bridges by all the states and local governments was \$27,000,000.

The incidence of the government upon the construction of federal roads under the supervision of engineers of the state departments has resulted in placing a much larger proportion of road work under federal direction.
