which the Citizens' Water Commission had in mind for the past six or eight months and to relieve any uncertainty as to the quantity of water available has had five test wells sunk at different points in the city. The purpose of these wells was to determine just exactly what the water conditions were and as a result of having had these test wells put in has been able to obtain definite information as to the water conditions in the city. The Citizens' Water Commission has been in at least three different sections of the village and procuring a preliminary output of at least 500 gallons of water per minute from each well.

By locating the wells at different sections of the village the present piping system will answer the present requirements together with the proposed increases in capacity. Instead of pumping the water from the wells into a storage tank on the ground there it will need to be pumped a second time before it can be pumped directly from the wells into a storage tank elevated to 100 feet above the ground in the vicinity of Lawford avenue and Ridgegate square so that any water which leaks will be immediately available for use without pumping at second time.

The great difference in the work proposed to be done by the Citizens' Water Commission and that recommended by Mr. Harnett is that the Citizens' Water Commission contemplated a definite 200 gallons of water per minute for the city's reclamation purposes rather than the 500 gallons of water per minute which Mr. Harnett's statement with the commission had in mind. It is not so much a question of cost as it is a question of whether the water supply is sufficient to meet the needs of the city. ## Let the People Know

That—  
the source of our trouble sometimes lies closer to our own doors than we may realize.

In the matter of saving on your gas bills, let us relate to you this little incident which actually occurred in a home we supply with gas.

The good woman had for a long time been in the habit of complaining about her excessive gas bills. The company sent an inspector to her house to see if he could discover the difficulty. He went to the basement and examined the gas meter and found it all right. He went to the kitchen and examined the stove and found it all right. While he was in the kitchen the woman entered to heat a cup of water for a sick child. The inspector watched to see how she did it. The water came to the boiling point and actually boiled over on the floor. The woman poured out the cup of water she wanted and turned out the gas.

It was easy enough to see why this woman's gas bills were excessive. It was entirely her own fault. The right way for her to have heated that cup of water was first to put a cupful in a small vessel, not a teakettle, set it over the burner and then light the gas. She could have heated the cup of water in about one-tenth the time and with one-fifth the gas required to heat the teakettle of water.

But still the good woman did not see why her gas bills should go so high. She came right to the office to make another complaint and the office manager having the inspector report before him told the woman very frankly that the fault was her own, told her how and why and told her also that if she conducted her entire household on the same basis on which she ran her gas stove, that her household expenses were probably ten times as much as they should be. This made the good woman indignant. But apparently it also made her thoughtful, for within two months she came back to the office to tell the manager how grateful she was to him for the very blunt advice for it had led to a reduction in her monthly gas bills of from \$8 to \$10, to \$4 or less.

Are you wonder how many times this same sort of thing has occurred in other homes. Has it occurred in yours? May we in your interest and in ours suggest that you take stock of yourself and the way you and those at your household use gas, to see whether any such thing as this can be causing high gas bills?
