LOCAL POOL ROOM LICENSE REVOKED BY COMMISSION

Gambling Alleged To Have Been Carried On In Rear; Commission Takes Action Monday Night

The license of the pool room at 127 East Maple avenue, said by local police to have been conducted by W. G. Buchanan, was revoked in an order issued by the Village Commission at its meeting last Monday night. Local police Captain Homer Gaskill and Lieutenant Clayton Stokes, acting under the direction of Manager Brown, closed the place late Tuesday afternoon.

According to the complaint made to the Commission, "trap shooting" was the chief gambling diversion held forth in the rear of the pool room. Hundreds of dollars are said by police to have changed hands there recently. A number of local men, together with local school boys, are claimed by police to have frequented the place.

According to Manager Brown, an elaborate system of alarm bells gave warning to the participants of the "game" of the approach of police who, it is said, have tried for several weeks to "get the goods" or first hand evidence that a game was in progress. The manager also said that many local parents had complained of the losses of their children to the games alleged to have been run there.

Don't get your pilot too high. Bake as much as possible at one cooking. Cook in as large quantities as practical; cereals, soups and foods that require long cooking but keep well.

Be sure to keep the vessels in which you boil water clean of scale. It takes longer and therefore more gas to heat a vessel coated on the inside with scale than one that is not. Water will deposit scale and care should be used to clean it out.
