SENATOR KNOX IS TAKEN BY DEATH

Pennsylvania Statesman Drops Dead in His Home at Washington.

JUST RETURNED FROM EUROPE

Stricken With Apoplexy as He Was Walking From the Library to the Dining Room for Dinner—Died Suddenly.

Washington, Oct. 13.—Philander Chase Knox, United States senator from Pennsylvania, former attorney general and secretary of the treasury, died suddenly in his home here.

Senator Knox long prominent in the nation, attorney general, secretary of state, senator from Pennsylvania, and as a candidate for the Republican presidential nomination in 1908, attained prominence in recent years by his steadfast opposition to the treaty of Versailles.

Washington, Oct. 13.—Robert E. Todd has been selected by President Harding as immigration commissioner at New York, to succeed Frederick Wallis, who recently resigned.
