ROADS CONSTRUCTED IN 1921

Approximately 28,000 Miles Built During Year Just Passed - Material Lower. (Prepared by the United States Department of Agriculture.) Road building has recovered from the setback received during the war, and prospects are bright for the future.

Approximately 14,000 miles of road were constructed during the present season by the states in conjunction with federal aid, according to the bureau of public roads, United States Department of Agriculture, and probably an equal amount of additional federal aid. More miles of improved road were built than during any other year.

With the new appropriation by congress of \$75,000,000 additional money will be available for the construction of roads. Many of the states are considering the use of this money to improve their roads.
