Illness That Was Not at First Regarded as Serious Has a Fatal Ending.

PONTIFF HAD BRIEF REIGN

Elevated to the Papal Throne in 1914, His Life Was Saddened by the Attractions of the Great War—Or—Gained Peace in 1917.

Rome, Jan. 21.—Benedict XV, the 95th sovereign pontiff of the Church of Rome, died late today at the Vatican. The end came after a day of extreme agony and delirium, relieved at times by moments of sleep.
