FIRST RESOLUTION FOR LATERAL SANITARY SEWER IN HAMSA FROM WATKINS ST. TO STANLEY AVE.

Moved by Commissioner Brown that the following preamble and resolution be adopted:

Resolved, that this Commission hereby recommend that it is expedient and advisable that a lateral sanitary sewer, with the necessary manholes and house connections, be constructed beneath the surface of Hamasa St. from Watkins St. to Stanley Ave. and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the center of the intersection of Watkins and Hamasa Sts. and extending eastward to the center of Hamasa St. a distance of 149 feet to the manhole at the center of the intersection of Hamasa St. and Stanley Ave.

It is further resolved that all the lots and parcels of land fronting and abutting on said street and having sewer connections shall be benefited by said improvement and shall contribute and pay the cost thereof in proportion to the frontage of each lot upon which a special assessment shall be levied.

It is further resolved that the Village Manager shall cause to be prepared and submitted to the Commission for its approval, a map and diagram of said lands and premises constituting said special assessment district, showing the boundaries and division of all lands and premises thereof, the proposed route and location of the sewer through the same with the proposed depth, grade, dimensions and all details together with an estimate of the cost of construction and sewer, manholes and house connections and appurtenances.

It is further resolved, that this Commission will meet at the Village Office in the Village of Birmingham on Monday, the 10th day of June, A. D. 1922, at 8:40 o'clock P. M., to hear suggestions and objections to the proposed assessment and the method of assessment thereon.

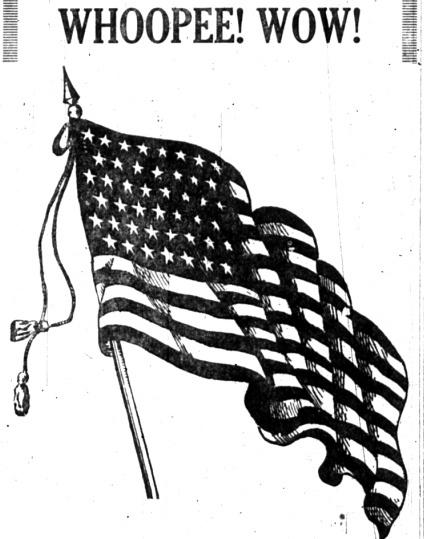
