LOCAL GRIDDERS TO OPEN SEASON AT H. P. Baldwin High School Team Meets Highland Park Pigskin Chasers Tomorrow

The Birmingham high school football team will open the season Saturday afternoon when they meet Highland Park on the Oakland athletic field, Detroit. According to reports from Highland Park the boys there seem to think they will have an easy time taking the local eleven's scalp. While Coach Drake would make no comment on the outcome of the game, he said Highland Park would know they had been in a game of football when they were done playing.

Coryell and Delong, who were injured last week, are expected to be in shape for the game Saturday. All the players, with the exception of Captain Ross, will be available for the first tilt. Ross' knee is still bothering him and it is not known when he will be back in the lineup. Davis, an end from last year's team, has entered school again. The fight for end positions is a bitter one. Hunt, a reserve end from last year, is showing up well. While Delong has been taking things easy because of a "charley horse," he will be a strong contender for an end job. Of the reserve squad, Schulz, playing center, seems to be a likely looking man for the first team. Making his first appearance on the football field, Simons is creating a good impression. He is fast and is being groomed for a half back. Smith, at quarterback, is playing his usual steady game.

Heavy scrimmage work has been indulged in this week, in preparation for the Highland Park conflict Saturday. This afternoon will be spent in light signal drills to polish up the plays for the first game of the season tomorrow afternoon.
