Favorite Recipes

NEW COFFEE CAKE

(By Mrs. C. G. Walker, 601 Pierce street.)

- 2 Cups flour
- 1 Tsp. baking powder
- 2 Heaping Tsp. melted butter.
- 1 Egg
- 1 Cup sour milk
- 1 Tsp. soda stirred into milk.
- Salt and nutmeg to taste.

Sift the dry ingredients together. Gradually beat in the liquids. Pour into shallow tin, and over the top pour the following before baking:

- 1-3 Cup sugar.
- 1 1/2 Tbsp. flour.
- 2 Tsp. melted butter.
- 1 Tsp. cinnamon.

MANSFIELD WAFFLES

(Mrs. Homer G. Leonard, Ferndale and Euclid avenues.)

- 2 Cups flour (Soft wheat preferred).
- 2 Eggs.
- 4 Tbsp. melted butter.
- 1/2 Tsp. salt.
- 1 1/2 Cups sweet milk. (Add enough more for right consistency.)

Beat the egg whites separately. After mixing the other ingredients well, fold in the whites, well beaten.

SWEET SALAD DRESSING

(By Mrs. C. R. Averill, 203 Poppleton.)

- 1 Cup sugar.
- 1 Cup vinegar.
- 1 Tsp. salt.
- 1 Tsp. cornstarch (rounding).
- Yolks of 3 eggs.
- 1 Tsp. butter.

Beat sugar, vinegar and salt. Mix cornstarch with a paste with a little water and add to the beaten yolks. When vinegar is about to boil, add to the fire and stir, stirring constantly. Return the mixture to the fire and stir until it is thick. Remove from the fire and add butter. This will make a pint of dressing which will keep indefinitely in a refrigerator. Mix a few tablespoonsful of it with whipped cream for fruit salads or ripe tomatoes.
