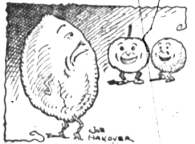

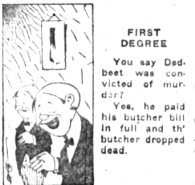

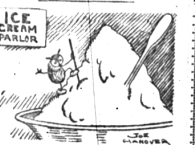

LAST CALL TO BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP TAX PAYERS

Until Tuesday, February 20th, I will receive all tax moneys at my home and will charge a two (2) per cent penalty.

From Wednesday, February 21st, until Friday, March 16th, I will also receive tax moneys and will charge four (4) per cent penalty.

After March 16th the tax roll will be turned over to the County Treasurer at Pontiac, where you will then have to pay your taxes; besides the four (4) per cent penalty, you will then have to pay one (1) per cent additional each month of continued delinquency.
