Mr. and Mrs. V. E. Smith of Brown street, are the proud parents of a baby girl, born June 1, she is called Audrey Edith.

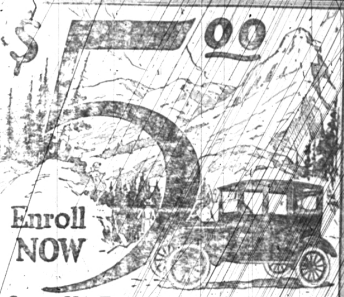
