IMPROVEMENT OF DIRT ROADS
Time to Find Out in Aiding Construction by Giving Attention to Neglected Highways.

Improvement of the present network of common dirt roads, (aggressive) is a matter of great importance, as urged by C. M. Krupar, engineer, as the next step in the better roads movement.
"According to statistics published recently," says Mr. Krupar in "Northwest Magazine," a national program for the completion of all 1,500,000 miles of the road within 20 years is practically a feat of being carried out. Physical growth of motor trucks and omnibuses service has thereby, at the same time been advanced, if the business stimulation required for the best utilization of these vehicles keeps pace with the yearly increase in road mileage. This much is true, and it is essential that a favorable development, if it is to be of any use to the motorist, must now be made to find out how much money may be done if the possibilities of the present road conditions are being exploited systematically by the business man and the engineer.
