Careful of Stickers

See that your customs declarations are securely attached to all parcels prepared for foreign countries.

Attention is called to the fact that the contents of all packages are subject to custom duty and all senders declare that clothing mailed was valued at from \$10 to \$25 and that the value of other goods is \$100 and that on account of the same the addressee may be liable for the value of the goods.

Foreign mail with stickers or Christmas labels attached to the address should not be mailed, but will be returned to the sender, if known, or sent to the division office if not known.

For any further information in connection with the stamps, postage, or the postmaster, assistance may be obtained from the post office or the postmaster.
