BOARD OF EDUCATION

Birmingham, Mich., June 24, 1924
Special meeting of the Board of Education was held in the office at 8 p. m. Present: H. B. Clement, R. J. Taylor, Leigh Lynch. Absent: Fred V. Quarton, R. E. Caryl.

R. J. Taylor offered the following resolution for adoption, supported by Leigh Lynch:
WHEREAS, at a special meeting of the qualified voters of School District No. 1, Fractional, of the Township of Bloomfield, Oakland County, Michigan, held at the Baldwin High School Building in said District on the 26th day of May, A. D. 1924, the qualified voters of said District by a majority of those present and voting at said meeting, authorized the Board of Education of said District to borrow the sum of Five Hundred and Fifty Five Thousand and Dollars (\$555,000) for the purpose of erecting, finishing and equipping a school building at Persse street, in said District.

BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the Board of Education of School District No. 1, Fractional, of the Township of Bloomfield, Oakland County, Michigan, issue the bonds of said School District in the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Five Thousand and Dollars (\$255,000) said bonds to be numbered from one (1) to two hundred and fifty five (255) consecutively and inclusively, to be each of the denomination of \$1000, to bear date June 1, 1924, and to become due and payable—
