sidewalks being built, rebuilt, and repaired in accordance with the most approved and modern methods. It shall also be the duty of the Village Manager, when permits shall be issued hereunder for the building, repair or repairing of any sidewalks as herein provided, to establish a report to be furnished for the use of the Village Manager, and the specifications to be followed in the construction of all sidewalks shall be built according to the grade established by the Village Manager.

Section 14. In event that the sidewalks to be built, rebuilt or repaired under the provisions of this ordinance shall become necessary for the city to perform such improvement, the Commission may, in lieu of the other methods provided by the terms hereof, create a special assessment district to defray the cost and expense thereof under the provisions of Chapter XXI of the Charter.

Section 15. In event that it shall become necessary because of any change in grade or hereafter established or hereafter established by the Village Manager to reconstruct or rebuild any sidewalk hereafter or hereafter built under the provisions of this ordinance shall be paid by the Village of Birmingham from the entire cost thereof. The Village Manager shall be authorized to include in the estimate for any sidewalk, driveway or alley and adjoining private or public building, the cost of grading, maintaining and repairing of the same.

Section 16. All previous ordinances or parts of ordinances, concerning the building, rebuilding, maintaining and repair of sidewalks are hereby repealed.

Section 17. This ordinance shall take effect on the first day of July after the passage thereof by the Commission of the Village of Birmingham, Michigan.

ORDINANCE NO. 116
Regulating the Building, Maintaining and Repair of Sidewalks.

Section 1. That hereafter whenever the Commission of the Village of Birmingham shall determine by ordinance or resolution that any sidewalk, driveway or alley of said village shall be built, rebuilt or repaired in the following manner: That the Village Manager shall be authorized to include in the estimate for any sidewalk, driveway or alley and adjoining private or public building, the cost of grading, maintaining and repairing of the same.

Section 2. That hereafter whenever the Commission of the Village of Birmingham shall determine by ordinance or resolution that any sidewalk, driveway or alley of said village shall be built, rebuilt or repaired in the following manner: That the Village Manager shall be authorized to include in the estimate for any sidewalk, driveway or alley and adjoining private or public building, the cost of grading, maintaining and repairing of the same.
