For Anti-Freeze Solution WE RECOMMEND

For Best Results >

Alcohol has for several years been the commonly accepted anti-freeze solution, but it is not ideal because its boiling point is only 173 degrees while that of water is 212 degrees, so that the alcohol evaporates and requires renewal in order to keep the solution at its proper strength. A strong alcohol solution, moreover, has such a low boiling point that it may boil under hard driving conditions, thus reducing the strength of the solution to a point where it will freeze at even moderately low temperatures.

#### ONE FILLING LASTS ALL WINTER

We, therefore, recommend that giverine be used. The original expense is greater but it hat a holling point of 554 degrees, so that none is lost through evaporation and the addition of water from time to time is all that is necessary. Giverine of 1.26 specific gravitylor 30 degrees Baume should be used in the following proportions by volume:

Glycerine-30% freezes at 12 deg. F. above zero

40% freezes at 2 deg. F. below kero

45 7 freezes at 8 deg. F. below zero

We suggest, and strongly recommend, the use of a suitable Winter-front or cover on the radiator, and lower covers for the openings in the side of the hood. The temperature under the hood must be of the same degree in the Winter as in the Summer, before any gasoline motor will function efficiently.


