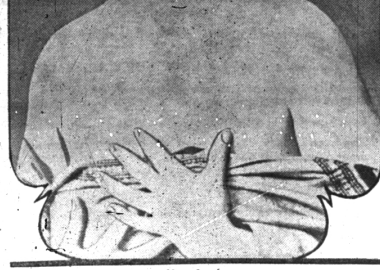
Small Town Girl Achieves Ambition When Radio Fans "Applaud" Her Singing

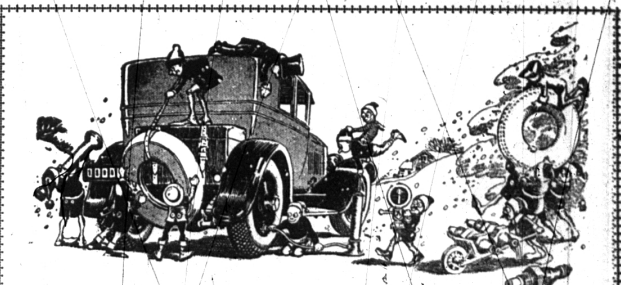

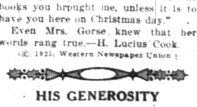
