VILLAGE TAXES DUE JULY 1, 1925

NOTICE is hereby given that Village Taxes for the fiscal year 1925 are due and payable at the office of the Village Treasurer July 1, 1925.

Payable without penalty up to and including July 31, 1925.

One per cent penalty from August 1 to September 1, 1925, inclusive. Four per cent penalty from September 1 to October 31, 1925, inclusive. No taxes accepted by Village Treasurer after October 31, 1925, as the tax roll will be in the hands of the County Treasurer at Pontiac for collection. All taxes unpaid after October 31, 1925, will bear the four per cent penalty plus three-quarters of one per cent for each additional month or fraction thereof.

ELECTION NOTICE

That the Township Board shall order the submission to the electors of the township at a special election to be held on the

14th DAY OF JULY, 1925

the proposition of acquiring land and erecting thereon a suitable memorial to the soldiers and sailors of all of the wars in which the United States of America has been a participant; at a cost of not more than \$60,000 or less than \$50,000, in accordance with a petition signed by not less than one hundred duly and legally qualified electors of said township and heretofore filed with the township clerk, all according to the provisions of Act 50 of the Public Acts for the State of Michigan for the year 1921. The form of ballot to be used to read as follows:

"Shall the township erect or construct memorial to the soldiers and sailors of all our wars at a cost of not more than Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) nor less than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00)."
