Development Seen In Southwest Section

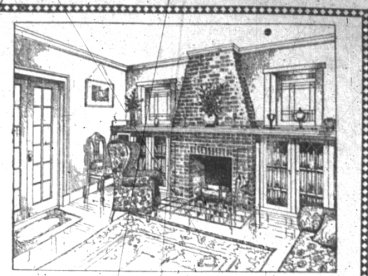
