**Obituary**  
Walter Stecker, founder and director of the Stecker Electric Company of Detroit, died last Wednesday at his summer home at Pine Lake. Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon at two o'clock at the Detroit residence of Gladstone avenue and burial was in Grandview cemetery. Besides his widow, two children, Walter George and Barbara, survive.  
Mr. Stecker, who lived all his life in Detroit, was also one of the patentees of the Eureka Vacuum cleaner. He was a member of the Pastelina Lodge, F. and A. M., the Detroit Commandery, and the Moslem Temple.  
Mrs. Stecker and the children will remain at their cottage at Pine Lake for the summer and will live in Birmingham during the winter months, having leased a dwelling on Oakland avenue recently purchased by Clarence V. Hemstreet.

**Thomas M. Wiley.**  
Thomas M. Wiley, a civil war veteran and an old resident of Oakland county, died at his home in Owosso last Tuesday evening, where he had been living for the last forty-nine years.  
Mr. Wiley was born in West Randolph, Vermont, on May 23, 1811, and was brought to Michigan by his parents when he was three years of age. The family settled in a field where the soil secured his education and learned to be a carpenter. Upon Lincoln's call duty to Birmingham and enlisted in Company D, 22 Michigan Volunteer Infantry, August 1, 1862, serving as a private, corporal, and sergeant. He was wounded at the battle of Chancellorsville, received his final discharge in 1865, returning to Owosso county.  
In Birmingham the soldier met Sarah A. Drake, a sister of a fellow soldier, and in 1868, Mr. Wiley married her. After eight years of residence in Birmingham when Flint they moved to Owosso, where they had been living ever since.  
Mr. Wiley is survived by his wife and one sister, Mrs. Susan Evans, all of Owosso.
