Uniform Traffic Rules For Entire State Are Prepared

(Continued From Last Week) Released by Safety and Traffic Section of Detroit Automobile Club

(Editor's Note: The Eccentric hereafter presented is a collection of statements on the proposed uniform traffic laws for municipalities in Michigan. It is expected that our readers clip these articles and keep them for future information and guidance.)

A speed limit of 15 miles an hour in the business sections and 20 miles an hour in the residential sections is provided by the ordinance with the exception that no vehicle shall be driven in an alley faster than 7 miles an hour.

Reckless driving is defined as the operation of any vehicle on the public highways in such manner as to endanger the life or limb of any person or the safety of any property.

In case of an accident to persons or property upon any public highway, due to the operation of any vehicle, the person operating such vehicle shall stop and give such reasonable assistance as can be given, and shall, upon request of the person injured or any other person, give such person his name and address and the number of his operator's license.

It shall be unlawful for any person under the influence of intoxicating liquor, or any stupefying drug to drive, operate, or be in charge of any vehicle upon any public highway. It shall also be unlawful for the owner of any vehicle, or any person having such vehicle in charge or in control, to authorize or knowingly allow the same to be driven or operated by any person under the influence of intoxicating liquor or any stupefying drug.

Any person violating the provisions of the preceding section of this ordinance, shall be fined...
