Rev. S. S. Marquis, of Christ church, Bloomfield Hills, has told members of the Birmingham branch of the American Association of University Women what he plans to do with the boys' school to be run in connection with the church.

He said that the school is to be located at the home of Mrs. R. C. Diserna, of Riverbrook avenue.

The idea of a school for 25 to 50 boys, to include the church choir, has enlarged under Rev. Marquis' energetic direction until it now, while under Episcopal direction and supervision, will be composed of boys of other denominations as well.
