Man Seeks Freedom From Jackson After 36 Years In Prison

Coming from within the confines of Michigan prison walls where he has been incarcerated for more than 36 years the appeal of H. Irving Latimer is to be presented to the people of Michigan. Muri H. DeFoe, editor of the Charlotte Republican, has sent copies of Latimer's appeal to the newspapers of the state, asking that they do what they can to bring it before the people to determine how they themselves feel toward his being given a chance to "make good" outside the prison walls.

Mr. DeFoe was secretary of the old pardon board and he says that it was at that time that he became impressed with the mental cleanliness of Prisoner Latimer, a capable expert among prisoners. He has consented to aid in bringing the case before the people through the medium of the newspapers.

Guilty or Not Guilty?
Latimer was convicted of the crime of murdering his mother. The case is certain to be discussed in the course of the next few weeks and after hearing both sides of a serious and ghastly story, it will be time to decide whether he has been punished sufficiently to satisfy the state and morally clean.

"He must subject himself to a more rigorous mental and physical discipline than required by imprisonment; to keep eternally busy and to keep scrupulously clean; to balance manual labor with an adequate amount of mental work with sufficient physical exercise; to keep himself physically, mentally and morally clean.

"Mind Conservers of Right"
"Still, however, rigorous discipline one may have imposed one does not survive thirty-six years imprisonment, maintaining mental and physical integrity, unless actuated and sustained by a greater power than self-imposed discipline, bulldog tenacity, or hope.

Friend Was Killed
"Within less than four years after imprisonment, still ranking under a keen sense of injustice, and escape. As a result of that escape an officer—a gentleman and my friend, died. There was no intent, no thought, no reason for his death. That he died has ever brought to me keenest regret and sorrow, and I have by my knowledge that his death was accidental, unpremeditated, and directly due to lack of medical attention. The immediate, personal investigation of Warden Chamberlain absolved me from all intent to harm, and a subsequent investigation by Warden Armstrong, of which I had no knowledge until the finding was announced, both freed me from malice aforethought and found the direct cause of Mr. Haight's death to be due to want of medical care.

"When returned to prison after that escape, I faced the deed as an unavoidable fact that I had then done something for which I should pay a penalty. I accepted that fact and believed that there would come a time when I could conscientiously feel that the penalty had been paid. In years past three offers to join in successful escapes, but I passed them by; there were opportunities, but I rejected them. In this there is no credit to me, for it was but in consonance with the determining resolve to accept the punishment and take it unwhiningly, because it was just.

Played Game Clean
"For the man who has undergone thirty-six years imprisonment, for the man who for thirty-two years has played the game, played it according to all its rules, and observed all its technicalities; played it conscientiously with fidelity and honor, doing what he had to do a little better than required, with the respect of prison officials and inmates, and playing it cleanly—not better, but so, but because it was right and fair and just that he so play it, who has maintained his hygiene and mentality and come through unscathed and uncontaminated—for that man, People of Michigan, what is there in the game for him?"
