### 5 GRASS FIRES KEEP LOCAL FIREMEN BUSY

Still alarms are increasing with the arrival of warm weather, is the report of Chief Olsen made public today. With the drying up of fields and things in general the possibilities of fires starting is greatly increased. Five or six still alarms were answered last week.

A still alarm is the name given to a call requesting the service of the fire department in the putting out of grass fires or fires too small to require the entire force. When such an alarm comes in, Chief Olsen collects a few volunteers and answers the call with out giving a general alarm.

Sunday morning, a fire that badly damaged the roof of Mrs. Williams' home on Big Beaver road, called a

number of firemen from the morning church services. Stanley Pepperaill suffered an injured hand while in the attic of the burning house. The cause was named as "sparks from the chimney."

The house now occupying the future site of the Village offices to be located on Pierce and Martin streets caught fire from the chimney and burned the roof slightly Monday

morning. Rubbish in back of the White Star Oil sub station on S. Woodward Avenue was put in flames when a railroad engine gave off live sparks which dropped upon the refuse. Nearby property was endangered but precautions were taken to prevent the fire spreading. The damage of both fires was slight.
