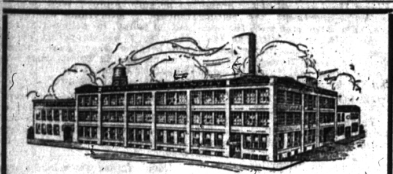


PLAYERS' EFFORTS ARE GIVEN PRAISE
