ORDINANCE NO. 137. VILLAGE PLAN. AN ORDINANCE to provide for a Village Plan Commission and to describe the powers and duties thereof.

res, or until their successors are elected and qualify; one of which members appointed shall be named chairman.

Section 2. The Village Clerk shall act as secretary of the Village Plan Commission and such Commission shall be empowered to acquire and use such lands as may be necessary to properly fulfill the functions approved by the Village Commission.

Section 3. The Village Plan Commission shall have the right to acquire and use such lands as may be necessary to properly carry out the work of the Commission in the planning, outlining and reporting to the Commission of all complete and comprehensive Village plans.

Section 4. It shall be the duty of each Village Plan Commission to inform itself of the progress and development of Village planning in such communities as have adopted such plans; make a thorough study of the needs of the City and on or before January 1, 1926, to tabulate all available data and present it to the Village Commission.

Section 5. The Village Plan Commission shall meet at least once a month and at such other times as may be deemed necessary by the Chairman and shall submit to the Board of Commissioners a report annually on or before December 31st in each year a report summarizing the progress of the work of the Village Plan Commission.

Section 6. The location, design, construction and improvement of public buildings and the ornamentation and beautifying of the same.

(f) A general plan for location of such buildings, bookshelves and community centers and play grounds adjacent to public buildings and the improvement, equipment and maintenance of such buildings.

(g) A uniform plan for development, construction and location of public utilities.

(h) The location, establishment and maintenance of such public utilities.

(i) Recommendations for the acquisition of such public utilities.
