**Woodward Visualized As Second
"Fifth Avenue" In Year 1950**

A visualization of Woodward avenue as it will be in 1950 may appear to be a task for a soothsayer, but to read a record of the development of what was once a narrow trail worn smooth by the moccasined feet of many Indians, rutted by the pole ends of the trees and unimproved horse-drawn to a paved highway ranging from 120 feet in width within the Detroit city limits to 200 feet west to Pontiac, beautiful structures of stone and steel, monumental art and mansions where once were crude huts and wretched land, seems to place the picture within the range of an ordinary mortal's vision.

It's appearance 24 years hence perhaps may best be determined by the projects planned for a comparison of the highway by a comparison of the growth and changes of important highways in other metropolitan cities. If the hopes and plans of those interested in the development of Woodward avenue materialize, it convention delegates and other visitors here in 1950.

Woodward avenue will be the most famous thoroughfare in the world. It will be a combination of Broadway and Fifth avenue in New York, Michigan Boulevard in Chicago, Union Square in Berlin, the Strand in London, and the other famous streets of the world's metropolises.

On its beginning with its inception on the shore of the Detroit River, will be the scenic drive extending from Lake St. Clair to Lake Erie; the Civic Center—Detroit's expression of civic consciousness in beautiful architecture; the banking houses embracing the financial heart of the city, the sky-scraping buildings housing its business and legal life; the theaters; shops and stores; the art center; luxurious hotels, beautiful homes and community centers that will all along this super-highway limit and perhaps even as far as Bay City.

There will be no street cars. They will have been relegated to less important streets and in outlying districts. In their stead will be rapid transit subways running the entire length of Woodward, diverting branches transporting people to the east and west. With the length of the Six-Mile road, six lanes of automobiles will travel, three north and three south. The fastest will use the center lanes, the slower the next two and the buses the lanes adjoining the curbs.

Every half mile the cross-town highways will intersect Woodward. These highways, planned to divert all of the traffic from converging in the center of the city near Cadillac Square, will range from 120 to 150 feet in width. The first will be the Vernor Highway beginning at Grosse Pointe, through the city to the west end of River Rouge. The next one will be the Mack-Middle highway beginning in Macomb County and going to Dearborn and Wayne. Warren and Harper will be the next highway to start at Mount Clemens, cross Woodward at Warren and go to Ann Arbor.

These highways, supplemented by the new loop, will materially relieve the congestion all over the city despite the increase in vehicular traffic. The loop, starting from the river, goes north on Second boulevard to High street, then east to Hastings street and south on High street to the river, beginning and ending with the scenic drive.

Just beyond where Grand boulevard intersects Woodward will be the new municipal air-drome, an innovation in airplane landing fields within a city. This air-drome consists of a building of four units, each unit a city block square, but joined by a single roof with an area of more than 3,000 square feet. The buildings, eight stories high, will be used as a garage to provide parking space for the thousands of automobiles that will be used by the workers in the business district surrounding the General Motors Building. Wide elevators, flush with the landing field roof, will take the airplanes down to the top floor of the building where hangar facilities will be provided.

The great developments in electric refrigeration and obtaining furnaces will make the city a much healthier place to live. The air circulating through the stores and offices will be washed and purified and kept fresh while the new heating units will reduce to a minimum soot and smoke.

Perhaps the street lighting will be the greatest advancement. The light as bright as day, will be softly diffused with no shadows.

In the year 1950 there will be a solidly built business thoroughfare linking the separate municipalities of Ferndale, Royal Oak, Birmingham and Pontiac into a Greater Detroit district. There will be business centers along this highway on or near the mile road intersections that will compare favorably with the present downtown business centers of Detroit. And for miles to the east and west will be developed highly restricted residential districts to house the population of this great area which will then contain nearly 8,000,000 persons.

"OLD SMIMMIN' HOLE"
