The name of no person but an actual resident of said Village at the time of regis-on, and entitled under the Constitution, if remaining such resident, to vote on the next election, shall be entered in the registration book,

REGISTRATION OF ABSENTEE BY OATH

If any person whose name is not registered shall offer and claim the right to vote at any election, and shall UNDER OATH, state that he or she is a resident of said Village TWENTY DAXS next preceding such election, designating particularly the place of his residence, and that he or she possesses other qualifications of an elector under the Constitution; and that owing to sickness or bodily infirmity of himself, or some other member of his family, or owing to his absence from the Village on public business or his own business, and without intent to avoid or delay his or her registration, which was unable to make application for registration on the last day provided by law for the registration of electors preceding such election, then the name of such person shall be registered, and he shall then be permitted to vote at such election. If such applicant-shall, in said matter, wilfully make any false statement, he shall be deemed guilty of perjury and, upon conviction, be subjected to the pains and penalties thereof.
