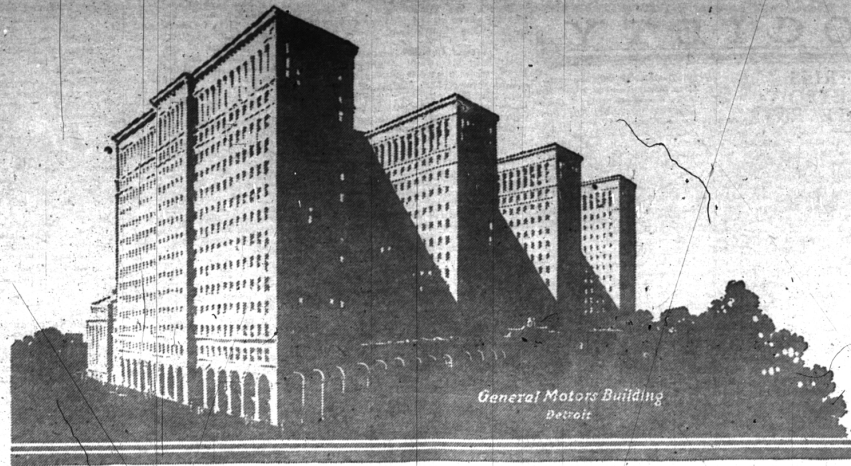


Foresters Hold First Open Meet
