COOLIDGE HIGHWAY TO OPEN BRADWAY SUB.

R. D. Baker Awarded Contract From Woodward Avenue To 12-Mile Road

Coinciding with the letting of the contract on a plan to pave Coolidge Highway, formerly Monnier Road, an announcement from the Judson Bradley Company's work on the subdivision in their Woodward-Monnier subdivision, located at the intersection of Woodward Avenue and the Coolidge Highway will be started at once.

The contract to pave the highway from Woodward Avenue to the Eight Mile Road was let to the R. D. Baker Company, with a guarantee that the work would be completed by November first. There will be two 20-foot concrete strips, with a wide parkway in between, all the way from Woodward Avenue to the Twelve Mile Road; one single strip 40 feet wide from the Eleven Mile Road to the Twelve Mile Road, and a strip of pavement 80 feet wide from the Eight to the Eleven Mile Road.
