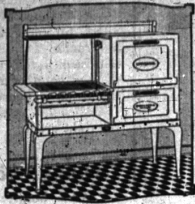

### Police News

Walter Tanner and Oscar Null, negroes, living in Pontiac, were arrested May 1 just north of Birmingham by Wright Needham, state policeman, on a charge of transporting liquor. The officer noticed the men looking around uneasily and on stopping the car found ten gallons of liquor in the tonneau.

When brought before Justice Buck Tanner testified that the car was his and that he had picked up Null near the Ford Motor Company where he was waiting for a northbound interurban. He pleaded guilty to a charge of transporting liquor and paid a fine of \$50 with an alternative of 30 days in jail. Null refused to plead guilty on the same charge, for according to him it wasn't his car or his liquor, why he had no idea that there was contraband in the car, and he wasn't even personally acquainted with Tanner, though he admitted that he had heard of him. Asked whether he had ever been arrested before he said, "Only four times in 11 years, your honor, only four times."

Upon further investigation of the case Justice Buck ordered Null locked up until he could get in touch with the Pontiac police and look up his record. Just before they left the courtroom someone asked the time and Null obligingly pulled at his long gold watchchain and out came, not an Ingersoll, but a woman's tiny wrist watch!

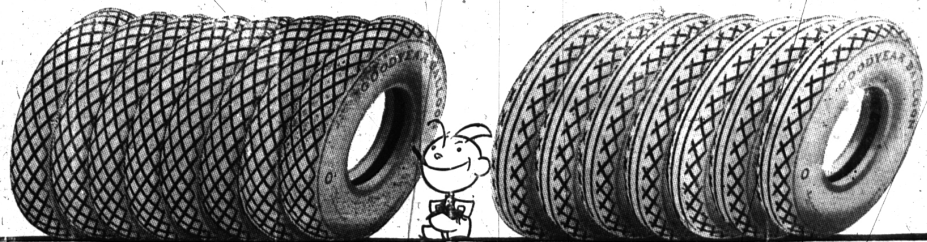
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
