(Continued from Page 1, Part 1) thoroughly on any possible contagious diseases, keep records of vital statistics and do other work along this line, he said.

A sanitary inspector would look after foodstuffs coming into the village. Milk, groceries, meats, and other commodities would be under his scrutiny, according to the plans. He would also take care of the waste disposal in the village and look to the condition of the streets and alleys.

The public health nurse, he said, would be able to survey the village from the standpoint of health giving instruction to persons afflicted, especially in the case of possible contagious diseases.

Dr. Nevitt declared thought on the matter convinced him of the necessity of such an improvement and reviewed that many other communities the size of Birmingham found these precautions to be a necessity.

No date was set for the presentation of the formal plans but it was agreed they would be given to the commissioners as soon as they possibly can be completed.

TOLERANCE PLEA MADE BY REV. EDWARDS HERE

A plea for vision and tolerance was made to members of the Young Men's Service Club at their regular luncheon yesterday noon at the Ochs Tea Room by the Rev. Thomas J. Edwards, pastor of the Baptist Church.
