To the Editor: I thought I had better correct the impression that some Birmingham people have that Birmingham is being served with milk that is not tuberculin tested.

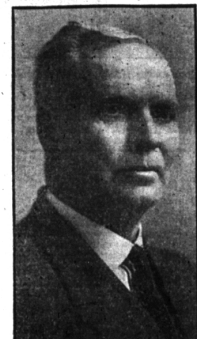
