

COMSTOCK MEETS VILLAGE DEMOCRATS

Gives Address To Citizens in Public Meeting

"Defects can be taken out of government by putting good men in." William A. Comstock, Democratic nominee for governor, told a group of Birmingham citizens at an informal meeting in the justice court room of the First State Bank Building last week.

Mr. Comstock stated that Woodward avenue, including the removal of the tracks, and completion of the widening through Birmingham should be pushed. He stated that he did not care to make a definite statement concerning any department of the state government, as he is practically impossible at present to know the exact status of the situation at the time. A fixed conservation policy, in his opinion, is needed, the candidate declared.

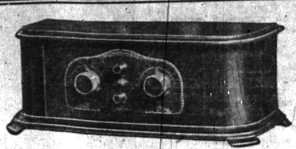
Most newspaper men shrink from the task of writing up a wedding, and prefer to pass that responsible duty to a female society editor. Yet there are exceptions. Occasion-
