

### BUICK ADDS FOUNDRY TO COST \$5,000,000

Increased Production Makes A New Plant Necessary To Employ About 1700, It Is Said.

Flint, Oct. 6.—For the second time within the last twelve months the Buick Motor Company has found it necessary to increase the production capacity of plant units in order to keep pace with the demand for cars.

The latest addition to the Buick factory is to be a \$5,000,000 grey iron foundry with a capacity of 500 tons of castings a day.

The new Buick foundry will cover about 12 acres of ground, and will be one of the largest and best equipped grey iron foundries in the world.

It will employ 1,700 men. Harry H. Bassett, Buick president and general manager, says that the new unit will be in production about next June.

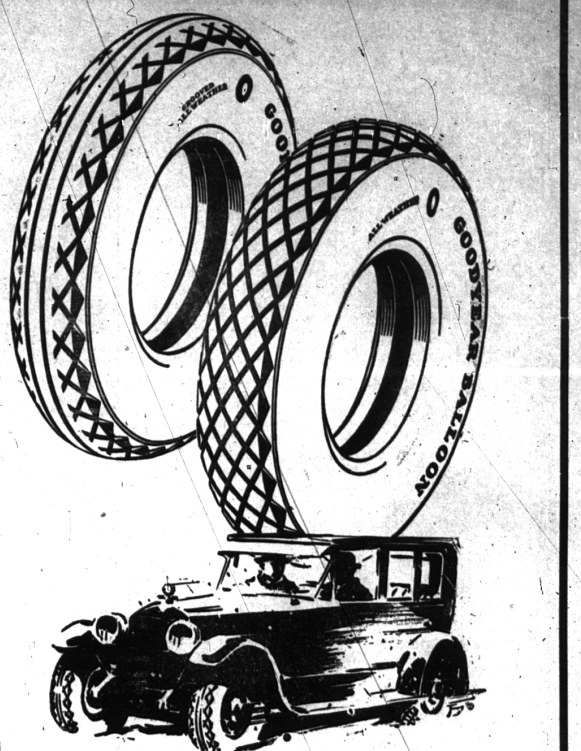
