

20 COUNTY TEACHERS MEET TO PLAN SCHOOL YEAR'S WORK

Lederle to Outline Plans For The Greatest Year So Far; Calls System Distinctive.

SOME SCHOOLS HAVE BEGUN

More than 200 teachers in the rural schools of Oakland County will meet Sept. 10 and 11 in the Court House, Pontiac, for a general meeting of plans for the year's work. E. J. Lederle, Oakland County commissioner of schools will outline the progress made during recent years and set the standards for this year.

All teachers have returned from their vacations and some of the schools in the county have resumed classes. Others will open at different times within the next two weeks.

Teachers Studied.

The district helpers as well as many of the rural teachers have attended summer school during vacation months. As a picnic given in Pontiac to more than 50 Oakland County students, teachers were present.

Dates At Variance.

This phase of the rural school management is not under the school commissioner's office but under the discretion of the local school boards. The opening dates are naturally of some variance, but the cooperation for any plan of endeavor is difficult under that system.

The four helping teachers in charge of rural supervision this year are Miss Jeanie H. Franston, Miss Ethel O'Connor, Maryann Ravell and Helen E. Stenson. The helping teachers have just returned from school commissioner's office from a three weeks vacation. Miss Franston spent two weeks at her home in Jordan and one week at the Wisconsin Rural Teacher's Institute. Miss O'Connor spent the entire summer weeks at her home at Whitmore Lake near Ann Arbor. Miss Ravell vacationed at her home at Belding, Mich., and Miss Stenson spent three weeks at her home at Covington.

Miss Ethel McCord, formerly of Flint, is in charge of the child accounting system in the rural schools. She will handle all child accounting in the county schools. Miss McCord's home is in Rochester.

FIRST UNIT OF UNIQUE GROUP NEARS FINISH

Woodward Avenue At Long Lake Road Scene of Considerable Building Activity.

The first of a group of buildings to be built by William T. Harbour at the southwest corner of Woodward avenue and Long Lake road, a filling station, is rapidly nearing completion. The finished group will contain 10 stores and a theater building.

Modeled on the English country type of architecture, the buildings are being constructed of old brick with a half timbered style. Old oak stained timbers are being used to give an aged appearance.

The walls of the gas station are up; the roof timbers are in place and the window and door frames are being put in now.

The foundations are finished and the walls have been started on the group of five stores, facing Woodward avenue.

Room for about 15 pumps has been left by setting the gas station on being constructed of a Michigan building to William M. Story, who is superintending the construction for Mr. Harbour.

Large refinishing companies is now being considered. It is planned to have the motor station on the east corner of Woodward and Long Lake roads to take care of the northbound traffic.
