VILLAGE ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 126
PROPOSED VILLAGE ORDINANCE
OF THE VILLAGE OF BIRMINGHAM

SECTION 1. Definitions.
For the purpose of this ordinance, certain terms used are hereby defined.

SECTION 2. Use District Regulations.
The Village of Birmingham is hereby divided into the following districts known as:

SECTION 3. "A" Dwelling District.
This ordinance shall be applied to all buildings or premises except as otherwise provided.

SECTION 4. "B" Dwelling District.
This ordinance shall be applied to all buildings or premises except as otherwise provided.

SECTION 5. Height and Bulk District.
In order to regulate the height and bulk of buildings, the area of yards and other open spaces, the percentage of lot occupancy, and the maximum number of families which may be housed, the Village of Birmingham is hereby divided into the following districts:

In order to regulate the height and bulk of buildings, the area of yards and other open spaces, the percentage of lot occupancy, and the maximum number of families which may be housed, the Village of Birmingham is hereby divided into the following districts:

"A" and "B" dwelling district the rear yard shall have a minimum depth of twenty-five feet, which shall be no less than five feet for each additional story of the building.

"SIDE YARDS: There shall be a side yard of not less than ten feet wide at the front lot line, separating adjacent lots.

"FRONT YARD: In a thirty-five foot lot and bulk district on lots fronting one side of a street between two intersecting streets, no building shall hereafter be erected or altered to be closer to the street than the minimum front yard of the building.

"REAR YARDS: There shall be a side yard each side of every building and bulk district in a fifty foot height and bulk district in a fifty foot lot and bulk district.

"STORY: A half story in a story shall be considered as one-half of the full height of the building.

"YARD, SIDE: An open, unoccupied space on a lot between the building and the side lot line.
