The dickey seat has become a definite addition to automobile convenience, even though it often has many drawbacks.

In the Buicks for 1927, four models are equipped with seats in the rear decks which are designed to overcome all objections to this type. In the series 115, roadster and two passenger coupe have them, while corresponding models in the larger series 123 are similarly equipped.

The Buick type of dickey seat swings low into the deck when opened, so its hinges are very nearly centered instead of being placed near the back end. This gives a very low and comfortable seat, and allows the passengers riding in it to look directly through the windshield of the car.

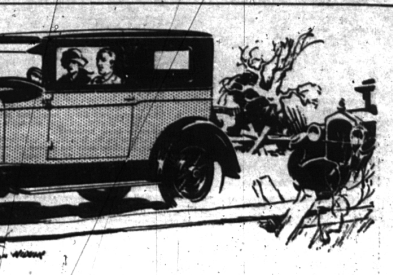

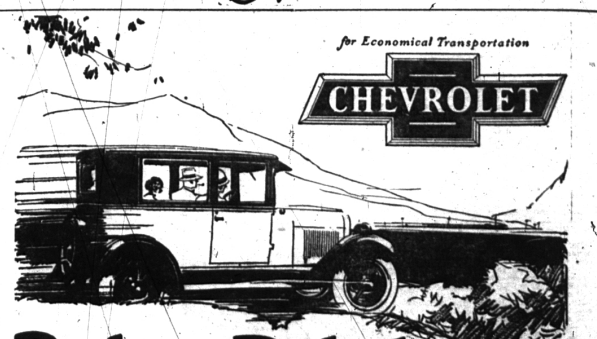
