

TRAFFIC VIOLATORS FINED BY POLICE

Minor Cases Handled During March, Report Shows; \$39 Collected

Thirty-one minor traffic cases netting \$39 in fines were handled by the traffic bureau of the police department during March, reports show.

Four of the cases brought \$3 fines, for violation of the traffic signal, according to the new schedule of fines. The other 27 persons received fines of only \$1.

A large number of the cases were parking with no lights. There were 12 such. Five cases were for overtime parking, four were for parking in the safety zone, four for parking all night and two for having no lights.

In addition to the traffic fines, \$4 was received by the police for killing four dogs, bringing the total of money brought into the department to \$45.

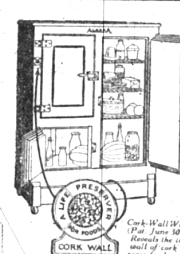

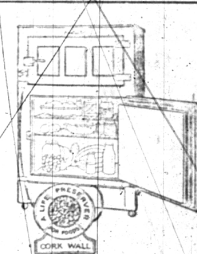

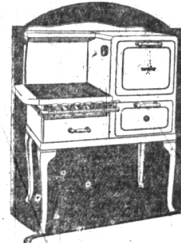
